

DEXA Scanner

Thanks to the incredible generosity of donors like you, the Mercy Medical Center Merced Foundation has been able to purchase a state-of-the-art DEXA scanner, (dual-energy X-ray absorptiometry). A DEXA scan uses two X-ray beams with different energy levels to pass through the body, usually the spine and hips and is a game-changer in the early detection and prevention of osteoporosis. This remarkable piece of technology is more than just a machine – it's a beacon of hope.


From the young athlete concerned about stress fractures to the aging parent wanting to stay independent, the DEXA scanner touches lives across generations.

The process is quick, painless, and provides doctors with crucial information about bone density. Your generosity has given our patients the gift of early detection and peace of mind.

The DEXA scanner is a powerful tool in our community's fight against fragility fractures, which can be life-altering events, especially for our elderly population.

Improving Cancer Patients' Experiences and Outcomes

Through the Radiant Wraps program, breast cancer patients trade stiff hospital gowns with a silky-soft, beautifully patterned Radiant Wrap that makes patients feel comforted and seen.

Hope on Wheels

Mobile Healthcare Clinic

The first step in quality healthcare is getting there. In emergency situations, an ambulance often fills this roll. But when it comes to preventive and routine care, it's up to the patients to get there and that can leave serious gaps in community care. For those with limited transportation, living in rural areas, or the unhoused, just getting to healthcare can be a mountain of a task.

Philanthropic Investments purchased the newest service line at Mercy Medical Center Merced – a mobile clinic providing access for marginalized populations in Merced County.

In partnership with Central California Alliance for Health (CACH) a state-of-the-art mobile clinic equipped with exam rooms, diagnostic equipment, and lab space, began September 2024, thanks to philanthropic support.

The Mobile Health Clinic offers bilingual services, routine health screenings, and connect the underprivileged community

members with services they need, such as social services, health insurance, and medical home.

“Our focus is to uplift the underrepresented, support the unhoused and serve the underserved by providing accessible, compassionate care.” said Jessica Escobar, RN, Director of Nursing at Mercy Medical Center Merced, “I am truly humbled by the dedication and support of our community partners.”

With this new mobile clinic, Mercy Medical Center Merced aims to dramatically expand its reach and provide high-quality, compassionate care to those who might otherwise go without.

As many of those serviced by the Mobile Healthcare Clinic are underinsured or uninsured, its creation from concept to launch, would be impossible without generous donors and philanthropy.

The Mobile Healthcare Clinic isn't just a vehicle – it's hope on wheels.

LUCAS Chest Compression

In emergency care, every second counts.

Through philanthropic efforts Mercy Medical Center Merced foundation purchased two LUCAS chest compression devices. These innovative tools automate high-quality CPR, providing consistent, uninterrupted chest compressions to cardiac arrest patients.

Reliable and safe chest compressions give first responders and patients the one thing that can't be bought - time. Time for physicians to give additional life-saving care, diagnostics and transport patients where they need to go for the next stage of care.

Your support enabled Mercy to purchase these essential devices, which has drastically improved health outcomes for the Merced community in emergency situations.



Rural Health Center Remodel

Mercy Medical Center Merced is just as committed to the best care in the Emergency Room as preventing people from needing it in the first place.

There will always be a need for Emergency Care, but regular preventive care has been proven over and over again to lessen the chances for emergency care.

Mercy Medical Center Merced began an extensive remodel of its Rural Health Clinic in 2024. This remodel has two main purposes: first and foremost to meet the growing demand for primary and specialty care. Second, it invests in the training for future family practice physicians through the UC Davis Family Practice Residency Program.

Residency programs are crucial ways to attract physicians to underserved areas and get them invested in our community. Thanks to a generous capital grant from the Central California Alliance for Health, services and facilities at the Rural Health Center are being upgraded.

This is an ongoing project expected to be completed in late 2025. Ongoing community support is vital to ensure Mercy Medical Center Merced is providing extensive care. It's no exaggeration to say the medical services offered here may be just what the doctor ordered to keep out of the emergency room.
