



Investing in North Georgia

CHI Memorial, local elected officials and business leaders broke ground Friday, March 22 on the long-awaited new hospital.

The new CHI Memorial Hospital Georgia will incorporate smart hospital technology solutions that help the hospital and staff meet the needs of the community, both today and well into the future, and bring a modernized patient experience to the present.

The new hospital in Ringgold will have 64 inpatient beds including an intensive care unit (ICU), as well as a full-service emergency department with 24 beds, five operating rooms, two endoscopy suites, comprehensive imaging services, non-invasive cardiac imaging, and laboratory. The new building will connect to the current CHI Memorial Parkway building creating a single campus geared toward establishing a central location for inpatient and outpatient services.

Community support is a critical factor in building the new hospital, just as it was 70 years ago when the then-Hutcheson Medical Center first opened. CHI Memorial Foundation gratefully receives individual contributions and grants from a variety of sources, including from family





foundations, corporate foundations, regional and national funders, as well as governmental grants. Our Foundation was pleased to receive a \$1.5 million federal grant for the new CHI Memorial Georgia hospital, endorsed by Georgia Senators Warnock and Ossoff. The anticipated opening for the new CHI Memorial Hospital Georgia is December 2025.

Facts About Mobile Lung Screening

Lung cancer screening is a test to look for signs of lung cancer in otherwise healthy people.

The low-dose CT scan shows a 3-D image of your lungs that is clearer and more detailed than regular x-rays, allowing doctors to diagnose lung cancer at its earliest stage, before there are any symptoms. This is when lung cancer is most curable.

The whole process takes less than ten minutes and there is no need to do anything special to prepare for the screening.

The low-dose CT lung cancer scan has been shown to improve survival by 20 percent according to The National Lung Screening Trial (NLST) by the National Cancer Institute (NCI).

Factors that put you at high risk of developing lung cancer include: Age 50 or greater: smoking history; family history of cancer; exposure to cancer causing agents (asbestos, diesel fumes, Radon, coal smoke, soot, etc.)

Grant funds are available for eligible uninsured and under-insured people to have the low-dose lung CT screening.



Another Breathe Easy Mobile Lung CT Coach is now on the road!

This is the second mobile lung screening coach for CHI Memorial's outreach efforts. to take critical lung cancer screening into the community, made possible by donors to the CHI Memorial Foundation.

The first Breathe Easy mobile coach was introduced in 2018. Since then, the coach has completed more than 10,000 scans as it has traveled thousands of miles throughout Middle and Southeast Tennessee and North Georgia.

With the addition of the second mobile coach, the impact will multiply as the program will be able to reach even more underserved communities and provide potentially life-saving screenings to those who need them most.

Funding for the second Breathe Easy Coach was provided by donations from a national and a local foundation. Ongoing support from these and other grantors assures no one is turned away from our mobile lung or mammography cancer screening coaches. CHI Memorial has a fleet of four mobile screening buses - all funded by philanthropy.

The Martin Cardiac Amyloid Center of Excellence in honor of Dr. Henry Cheng

Cardiac Amyloidosis is a deadly condition in which abnormal protein deposits in cardiac tissue results in congestive heart failure. Even though Cardiac Amyloid is not a newly discovered disease, we are beginning to hear much more about it because treatment is only recently available to stop disease progression. Early diagnosis and treatment is critical.

Data indicates approximately 20-30% of patients over the age of 65 with diastolic heart failure have undiagnosed Amyloidosis with a much higher percentage in African-American patients. In fact, patients often go undiagnosed until they are in end stage heart failure.

Ultimately, we envision a dedicated space where patients and families will have diagnostic testing, clinical evaluation, counseling, and treatment all in one location.

Funds will be used to renovate dedicated program space, and purchase new and update existing Echo machines with Amyloid diagnostic capabilities.



The Martin Cardiac Amyloid Center of Excellence led by Dr. Henry Cheng will be the first comprehensive amyloid program in the United States.

Over the last 12 months the CHI Memorial Foundation was able to fulfill a \$2.5 million dollar matching gift from a grateful patient to bring this program to reality.

Philanthropic support will also help with program start up to include community education and outreach efforts, and hire necessary program staff including Advanced Nurse Practitioners, a nursing coordinator, on-site social workers, and a geneticist.

In addition to the Amyloid screening and treatment program, this center will also house a cardio-oncology program in partnership with Tennessee Oncology to initiate a cardiotoxicity screening program for patients undergoing targeted chemotherapies.

In just the first year, the Amyloid program has diagnosed 80 patients and identified three families with the genetic mutation carrying the disease across numerous family members.

We anticipate screening at least 1,500 individuals, not including broader community events, over the next five years and more than 300 patients diagnosed with Amyloid.

Arts Therapies and Well-Being **Program Benefits From Grant Award**

CHI Memorial's Arts Therapies and Well-Being Department is proud to be a recipient of the Just One More grant award for Arts Therapies for their work in the Chattanooga community.

CHI's Music Therapist/Community Relations Coordinator Alexandria Rodriguez (MT-BC) has partnered with the Chattanooga Public Library and Avondale Community Center over the past 1.5 years to offer students and community members ages 7-18 the opportunity to engage in creative arts.

Students participate in activities on a weekly basis with goals of expression, emotional regulation, group dynamics, identity development, stress reduction, and learning about community and culture through the arts.

Activities range from songwriting, group drumming, and boomwhackers to collagemaking, group murals, mosaics, clay stop motion, storytelling, and much more as ways to engage their minds, heal, express, and learn in a therapeutic environment.

Whether making art alone, with family, in the community, or with a creative arts therapist, creative coping can help us work our way to better health.







A Journey of Hope: The Schmissrauter Center for Cancer Support

The diagnosis of cancer can be a life-altering event, filled with uncertainty and fear. But at CHI Memorial, the Joe and Virginia Schmissrauter Center for Cancer Support offers a beacon of hope, providing comprehensive and compassionate care to patients and their families throughout their journey.

"Our goal is to support the patient and their family in every way possible," says Kim Shank, BSN, RN, OCN, the center's oncology clinical services director. "We believe in a holistic approach, addressing the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of each individual."

The Schmissrauter Center is a testament to the power of collaboration, bringing together a dedicated team of professionals under one roof. Eight nurse navigators guide patients through the complexities of diagnosis and treatment, offering clarity and support. Three oncology social workers address financial and legal concerns, provide counseling, and help manage stress. Three oncology dietitians ensure patients receive the optimal nutrition they need to maintain strength and well-being during treatment. An oncology chaplain offers a listening ear and spiritual guidance, providing comfort and solace. The center also offers physical therapy and genetic counseling services.

This comprehensive approach to care is made possible by the generosity of our donors. Thanks to grants from the American Cancer Society and an anonymous foundation, as well as countless individual contributions, all services at the Schmissrauter Center for Cancer Support are free of charge. No insurance companies are billed, ensuring that every patient receives the support they need, regardless of their financial situation.

The de Lellis Society

The de Lellis Society is a group of young professionals who are committed to improving the health care of the greater Chattanooga community by giving \$2,500 or more annually.

The de Lellis Society honors the legacy of Saint Camillus de Lellis, the patron saint of hospitals and the sick. Saint de Lellis did not immediately feel called to ministry, becoming ordained at the age of 34. He felt moved to provide better care for patients suffering in hospitals, particularly the poor, and assembled a group of lay followers to help tend to those in need, calling his group the "Servants of the Sick." The de Lellis Society seeks to honor this faith-based commitment to improve care for the sick, and like de Lellis himself, identifies with early and mid-career individuals.



MaryEllen Locher Scholarship Fund & MEL's Club

The MaryEllen Locher Scholarship Fund at CHI Memorial Foundation has awarded 31 college scholarships totaling \$90,000 to Chattanooga area students for the 2024-25 academic year. The fund is a college scholarship program for children who have either lost a parent to breast cancer, have a parent who is a breast cancer survivor, or have a parent who is



currently in treatment. The organization was founded as an independent nonprofit in 2002 by

MaryEllen Locher, a long-time news anchor and health reporter for WTVC in Chattanooga. Formerly known as the MaryEllen Locher Scholarship Foundation, it joined with CHI Memorial Foundation in January 2021.

MaryEllen started the foundation during her own battle with breast cancer because she was concerned about her son's future education. She did not want other parents to share that concern while they were struggling with this disease. MaryEllen passed away in 2005 after her third bout with cancer. Over the past 22 years, the fund has awarded nearly 600 scholarships totaling more than \$1 million. The awards are designed to ease the emotional and financial burdens faced by families dealing with breast cancer. Recipients for the 2024-25 academic year represent 14 area high schools in Southeast Tennessee and North Georgia.

"Mel's Club" is the educational component of the MaryEllen Locher Scholarship Fund. Launched in 2014, Mel's Club has educated thousands of girls in area high schools on the importance of breast health beginning at an early age. Mel's Club equips students in three key areas: myths and misconceptions regarding breast cancer; facts, warning signs and prevention; and tools and training in how to do a breast self-exam. A breast cancer survivor also shares her story. Participants receive a packet of information to take home and share with other women in their family.

The Friends of CHI Memorial Council, led by co-chairs Patti Dungan and Kathy Mahn, guides a team of community volunteers in raising funds this fiscal year to provide essential medical care to patients ensuring access to quality health care for all, regardless of their financial circumstances.

Because of the generosity of many donors to CHI Memorial Foundation, essential care was provided to those most needy in our community through:

CHI Memorial Community Health Center - Hixson: This Health Center provides primary care to underserved and vulnerable populations in our community including those who are low-income or uninsured.

Center for Cancer Support: A cancer diagnosis can be very stressful for patients and their families. The Joe and Virginia Schmissrauter Center for Cancer Support offers guidance and a full range of holistic care. All services are free to cancer patients and their families and no referral is needed.

Mobile Health Buses: Providing access to screening and early detection is paramount to good health care. CHI Memorial has two mobile mammography buses and one low-dose mobile lung CT screening bus covering 28 counties across Tennessee, Georgia and Alabama. These buses provide the latest in breast and lung screenings to women and men, many of whom might not otherwise have been able to afford or access screenings.

Recognizing that there are many in our community would benefit from learning more about the services and programs offered at CHI Memorial, the Council not only actively raised needed funds, but also sponsored two educational programs for the community featuring nationally known speakers. Funds were also raised to provide four college scholarships to health care professionals specializing in nursing.

Our CHI Memorial employees have always answered the call, giving over \$3.5 million dollars since the programs inception in 2003 through contributions to the MAGIC program.

The 2022-2024 MAGIC Campaign supported the Employee Emergency Fund to provide employees with financial assistance during a time of crisis. Since 2003, 594 employees have received help from the Employee Emergency Fund for a total of \$393,489. Departments across our three campuses received much needed equipment and program support with grants totaling \$318,000. Finally, a third of gifts to MAGIC were earmarked to equip our new Georgia hospital facility set to open FY25.

- Student Volunteer Anna Qualey, a UTC graduate, has volunteered at CHI Memorial since she was 16. "That time has been a driving force in my life. The volunteers helped me take initiative and built my confidence. They were excellent mentors and helped me choose my life career in physical therapy." Student volunteers have returned to serve at CHI Memorial as physicians, nurses, and leaders.
- A volunteer was praised on social media: "I have never ever ever ever ever experienced such a caring hospital. As soon as I got out of my truck with my cane, a volunteer met me with a wheelchair. The Auxiliary raises funds to enhance patient care, in addition to their hours of service.

The Auxiliary has pledged to give \$30,000 over three years to the North Georgia Hospital currently under construction, and the Board recently pledged \$2,500 for the purchase of new clothing for the Comfort Closet, which volunteers maintain for patients in need being discharged from the hospital.

For almost 30 years, funding has been provided for a "We Care Weekend" retreat for cancer patients. This year, the Auxiliary gave funds for "We Care Saturday" at beautiful Willow Tree Farm in Georgia. Volunteers also helped share resources on Cancer Survivors Day.
